That the Montreal coalition call to participate in the demonstrations of March 8, including the demonstration at Square Cabot at 18:30.

That the Coalition call for a demonstration in Montreal in the afternoon on March 8th.

That the Coalition invite other regional coalitions to join this event.

That the Coalition calls for a day of strike for March 8th.

That this event address the issue of sexual violence in schools through unpaid internships and be organized in collaboration with other groups with the mandate to do so.

Representation

Considering that members of the National Assembly do not have a sufficient understanding of the situation for interns;

Considering that the reality of interns is different from one field of study to another;

Considering that it is important to put interns' voices forward;

Considering that the National Assembly foresees changes to the Labour Code, and that the Minister of Higher Education has committed to study the issue of unpaid internships;

Considering that AVEQ can offer human resources, media support, and finances to organize the logistical needs for an interns' forum;

Resolved that the coalition participate in the creation of an interns' forum in Quebec, in collaboration with AVEQ;

Resolved that AVEQ invite representatives of political parties, with the goal of informing them so that they can clarify their positions on the matter.
